Many of the audience members at Livonia Civic Chorus concerts are senior citizens, mobile elderly who can still go to such events on their own or with the assistance of family and friends. But what about the Livonia seniors who are unable to travel to the concert venue from their care facilities?

We know from research that there is a positive impact of music on health. For elderly people, music has been shown to not only reduce tension and anxiety, but also help reduce the feeling of isolation and solitude. There are many senior care facilities in Livonia where we can offer our musical services.

What is "Musical Interlude for Seniors"? It is a 45-minute choral program on either a Saturday or Sunday beginning at 3 p.m. in the afternoon by members of the Livonia Civic Chorus. The Chorus is now in its 59th Season of providing two Concerts per Season, many other Community Outreach Events and this "Musical Interlude..." program for the Livonia Community.
